



## Temporary POD Storage System Rules

Placement of a temporary storage container or “POD” shall be allowed with the prior written approval by CSC (Community Services Coordinator). A permit will be issued to the homeowner to be displayed on the container.

The approval will be issued for a period of five (5) days. The time period may be extended by the CSC for unusual and reasonable circumstances upon request.

Temporary storage containers must be placed on the residence driveway and may not overhang the driveway or block any public right of way.

A \$50 deposit must be paid to the Association prior to the container being delivered. This deposit is refundable only if these rules are fully adhered to. If the rules are adhered to the deposit will be returned to the homeowner when the permit is returned to the CSC.

Damage to walks, driveways, curbs, landscaping, fixtures, etc. on any Lot or Common Area is the responsibility of the Owner or resident. Any resulting damage shall be repaired or replaced at his/her sole expense.
