

Concerns over SB 1035 and HB 2259

According to a report given by Oro Valley Councilperson K.C. Carter at the June 23rd SCVCAI Board of Directors Meeting, passage of the above noted bills would create a tremendous financial burden for Oro Valley and many other municipalities.

Very briefly summarized, these bills, if approved would result in very restrictive use of development impact fees paid by new developments. For example, impact fees could not be used for regional parks, libraries, solid waste, drainage or other governmental facilities.
